## Compassionate care — Supportive Care team

Supportive care, from diagnosis onwards, addresses the holistic needs of patients and their caregivers. The **supportive care team** consists of a palliative care physician, nurse educators, social workers, and volunteers. This team provides service and assistance on a one-to-one or family basis. Self referrals are encouraged. Through direct physician-to-physician referrals, our palliative care physician(s) will see patients in the home and in hospital. They work very closely with The Hospice supportive care team to provide total pain and symptom management. The **supportive care team** addresses the physical, social, emotional, and spiritual needs of our patients and families.

## Resource Library

Knowledge is empowering, and The Hospice is committed to providing the best and most current information. The Resource Library is electronically linked with the Windsor Public Library. This allows patients and their families access to additional sources and enables them to become partners in their own care.
